WHAT: Theater Magic: Technology, Innovation, and Effect – Points Event


WHEN: Saturday, February 15th


WHAT: Skiff Craft Wooden Boats Open House - Points Event

In 1959, the company relocated to Plain City, Ohio, and was renamed Skiff Craft. There, veteran craftsmen of local Amish and Mennonite communities custom build each exceptional Skiff Craft boat using their time-honored woodworking skills.






### Scioto Society Page — The Model A Ford Club Women's Page


The ladies have arrived! It is going to be so much fun to have a corner of the Scuttlebutt to share with the wonderful women of the Scioto Model


