Time: 7:00 PM

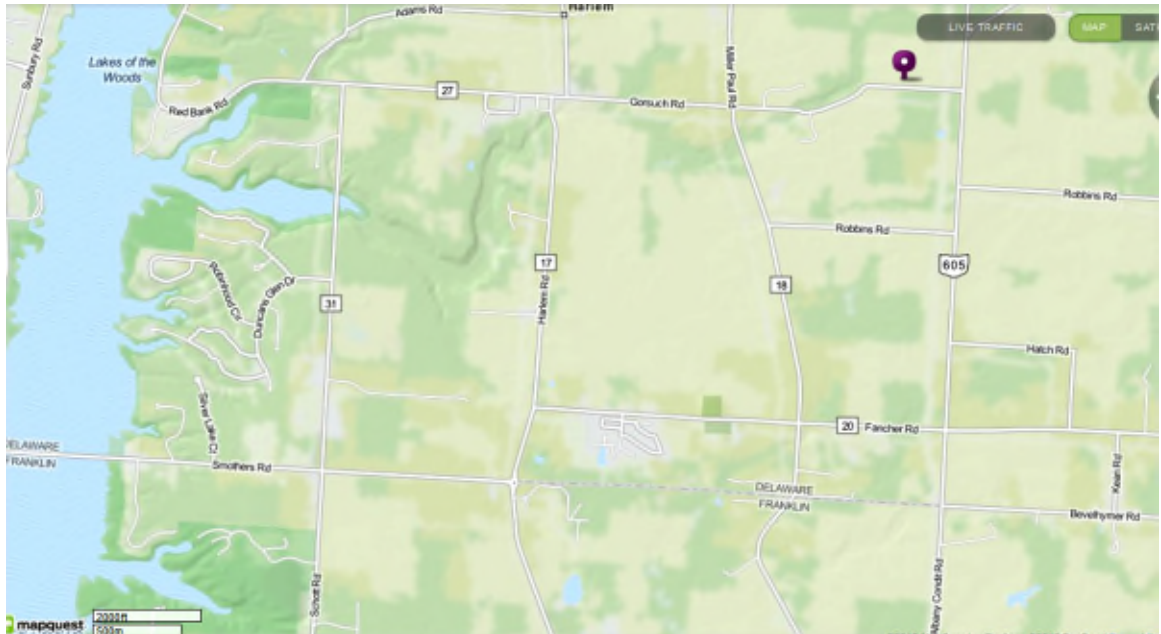
Place: Dan and Kathy Bickley's.....12805 Gorsuch Road, Galena

2017 Club rosters are now ready. They will be available at the tech meets and tours. A revision of the pdf file will be emailed soon which contains some corrections.

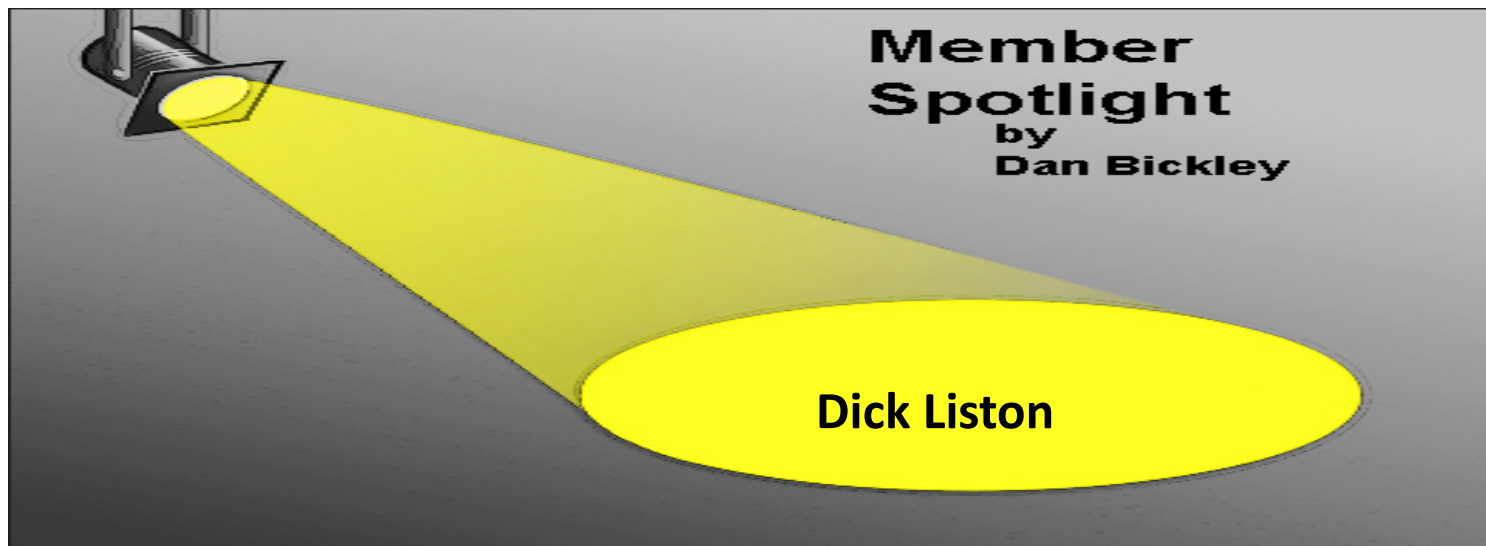

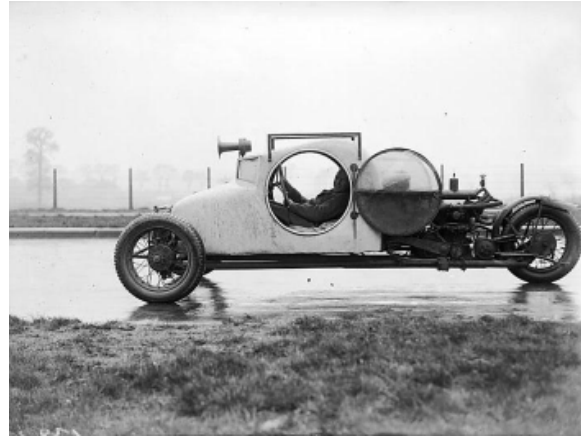
