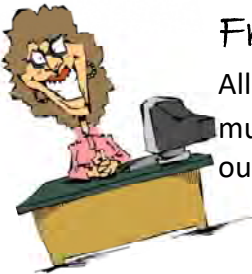

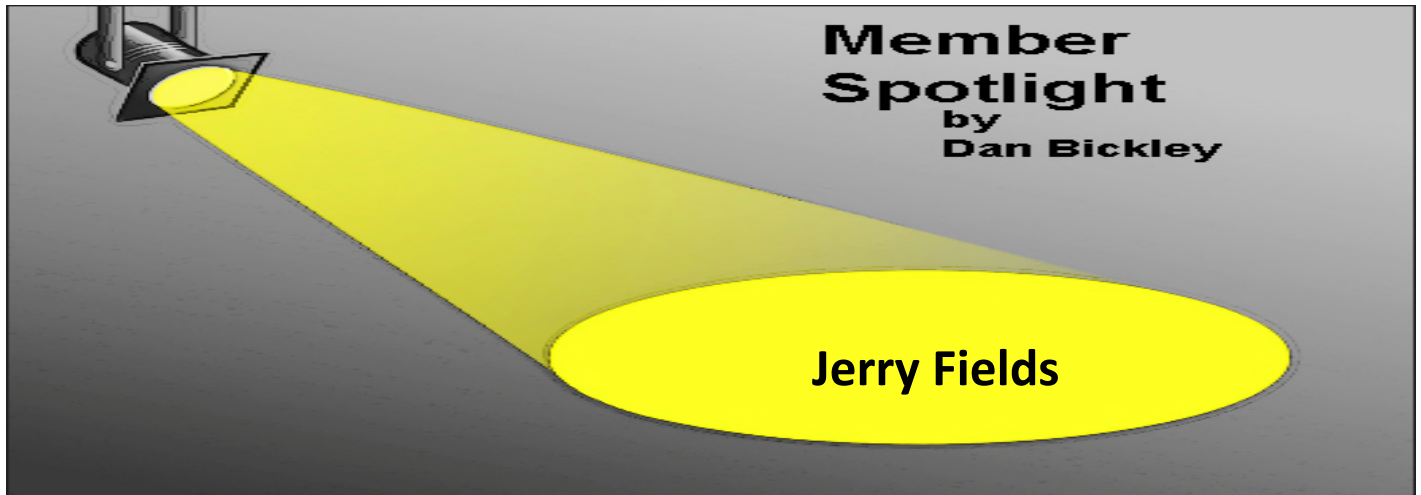
10. Richard discussed the Bean Dinner at Don Mink's on September 9.
